

Minutes of Board Meeting
Newcomers of Catawba County
November 25, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President Cathi Montgomery at 10:39 AM via Zoom. Aside from Cathi, present at the meeting were Vice President Rob Herman, Past President Delilah Bragg, Secretary Chris Beckom, and Directors Adra Kryszczuk and Amy Chizen.
