CCM will focus on meaningful and lasting ways to address long term issues by looking at all facts of individuals (education, medical, financial, and housing). During a ten month period, 15,000 people were served and \$105,000 provided for utility bill assistance.

- o Thrift store
- o Organize a group to prepare one meal a month
- o Pharmacy which provides 25,000 prescriptions per year
- o Dial 211 to obtain information on CCM
