Home Falls - #1 Accident

Preventative measures include proper lighting, de-clutter, eliminate throw rugs, install
rails, add slip resistant runners, understand medicines creating dizziness, know
frequency of taking medications, exercise and walk. Call 911, stay with the person, do
not move the person unless they are in danger. Make sure the scene is safe, check if the
person is responsive and shout for help.

Low Blood Sugar

• Give orange juice, whole milk, jelly beans, soft chewy candy.

Stroke – Signs of a Stroke

- Face droops
- Arms show weakness
- Speech is slurred
- Time to call 911
