Cooperative Christian Ministries (CCM) is the quarterly through March 31, 2018. CCM provides supplemental groceries for people facing a crisis situation. The Nutrition Center provides monthly groceries for seniors who live in residential settings. The thrift store provides assistance to people in need of clothing and household goods, at no cost.

PROGRAM: Miracle of Hickory (Polio Epidemic in Hickory, 1944)

Chris Simmons presented information on the 1944 polio epidemic in Hickory. For more information, the following book is available through CVCC.

Hickory addressed the Polio Epidemic of 1944 by building two permanent wards within 54 hours. Approximately 400 children received treatment in Hickory, with 12 children dying during this period. Quarantines extended to children 12 and under who were prevented from attending church, movies and picnics. New forms of treatments were pioneered during this

time, The Kenny Treatment was not accepted by the medical profession. The treatment was accepted by the March of Dimes as a method providing better use of muscles by the use of heated wool blanket wraps.
