One of the biggest recent success is the start of the Trivium Corporate Center, a business park financed by Catawba County, the city of Hickory and Millar's nonprofit group. The 270-acre business park has announced its first tenants - Corning's cable manufacturing plant and a German firm, ITM, which will make radiopharmaceuticals for treatment of cancer. Millar was one of the leaders who beloed bring Apple's data

Apple initially said it would invest \$1 billion in the site in Maiden. Since then it has spent almost \$5 billion and is Catawba County's single largest taxpayer.
