Go to the web site <a href="http://www.newcomersofcv.com">http://www.newcomersofcv.com</a> Click the directory button and enter the new words where shown. The directory itself has been updated to show only current members. Kindly remember that the directory is for the private use of members. No commercial or promotional use of this list is allowed.

Allow me to clarify how one replies to a message sent through our distribution list. If you click REPLY in your email program, it sends a message to the originator. If, however, you click REPLY ALL, it goes out to everyone in the group. And too, there are some mail programs that default to reply all. Please check your settings. If in doubt, give me a call. Remember that you are in control of who sees the reply.
