Notes from our President:

\$800 donations

Newcomers, once a year our organization makes a significant contribution to nonprofits in the four counties we serve – Catawba, Alexander, Burke and Caldwell. This year, the Newcomers' board of directors voted to give \$200 each to libraries in those counties.

Instead of the money going into the libraries' general fund, the money has been sent to Friends of the Library in each county. These volunteers from the community typically give their time and talents to supplement programs and operations of public libraries, from used book sales to special readings for children.

This \$800 contribution is in addition to the quarterly charities that Newcomers supports with the money and supplies you bring to our monthly meetings and card games, as well our monthly 50-50 drawing. Those donations go to the areas where most of our members live – Hickory, Newton-Conover, Alexander and Caldwell counties. Last quarter, our charity was the Good Samaritan Food Pantry in Bethlehem. Currently, it is The Corner Table, which feeds the hungry in Newton. Thanks for your generous contributions.


Quarterly Charity
