For a small group that has an annual budget of only about \$3,000, that combination has been impossible to beat. Believe me, we've looked. We investigated rec centers, churches, clubhouses and restaurants. But we couldn't find anything close to the financial bargain we get at the airport.

The City of Hickory owns the airport and leases space to Crosswinds Cafe's Teresa Rozzelle. If we buy meals from Crosswinds, we use the meeting room free. That is the situation for Day Canasta, the two Game Nights and several potlucks each year. If we don't buy food, we have to pay Crosswinds \$75 to rent the room. That seldom happens.

Teresa cuts us a very good deal for our monthly meeting. She should be charging us \$75 to use the room since we do not buy food, but gives it to us free if we buy \$20 worth of coffee. So if you get tired of meeting at the airport, now you know why we're there so often.
